The meeting committed to holding the stalls as outlined in previous updates, however we need to have conveners locked in at the beginning of Term 2. If there are no confirmed conveners for stalls, stalls will either be combined or they will not be held. Some stall conveners have been confirmed, but if you are interested in being involved in the Community Bash as a stall convener, please let the school office know by the end of Term 1. No prior experience is required. If you are interested in being mentored with the view of being a stall convener at the 2019 fete, please let the school office know. The list of stall conveners will be released as soon as they are finalised.

The success of the Community Bash relies on the support of the school community. Details of the items required will be outlined via updates in Term 2. However, the plants stall needs to start growing plants in time for the event and needs lots of pots as soon as possible. If you have any pots (any size, shape or quantity) that you no longer use, these would be greatly received. The target for one hundred pots is what is required for the plants stall. Any donations of pots can be left at the school office from now until the end of Term 2.

This year, there will be a competition to sell the most books of multi-draw raffle tickets and the prize will be four (4) wrist bands for the rides.
