Anyone interested in being the convener of any of these stalls, please let the school office know ASAP. Below are some of the duties of a stall convener:-

- Manage the stall, including organising the goods for the stall, setting up the stall on the day before the fete, selling the goods on fete day, controlling the money and packing up after the fete)
- Attending fete planning meetings where possible and liaising with the site manager about stall location and any requirements for running the stall
- Keep a record of the goods on the stall, what sold well, what did not sell well, suppliers, pricing of the goods for the purposes of future fete planning
- Take part in the fete review process

No prior experience is required to be a stall convener, other than to have some fun and create a good positive vibe around the fete.

The success of the fete relies heavily on the support of the school community by way of the donation of good quality items that can be sold on the stalls. Some items that we are looking for include:-

- The Pre-loved and Vintage Goods Garage Sale stall:-
  - Pre-loved clothes, shoes or toys
  - CDs or DVDs
  - Manchester (bathroom, kitchen, bedroom items)
  - Household items (kitchen or garden utensils)
- Books, including fiction and non-fiction
- Spare pots, plants or plant cuttings and cool-lite boxes for the Plants Stall
- Home-made jams and chutneys
- Empty glass jars with lids (for jams)
- Cakes of all sorts
- Sweets, including slices, tarts, pies, lollies, toffies, fudge
- Arts and craft items
- Blocks of chocolate and other novelty items as prizes for the Sideshow Alley games
- Cans of soft drink (375ml) and bottled water (425ml) for the Café/BBQ
