# St Brendan's Community Bash 2018

**Sunday 26 August      9am to 3pm**  
**Update No. 6**

The 2018 St Brendan's Community Bash is a little over 12 weeks away and there is a lot to do. Having said that planning is progressing well!

At the last Fete Planning meeting held on Saturday 19 May, it was decided to amalgamate the Books stall with the Pre-loved Goods stall. This is because there were no nominations to be the convener of the Books stall. We are still seeking nominations for the following stalls:-

- Multi-draw raffle
- Silent auction
- Plants

If anyone is interested in being the convener of these stalls, please let the school office know ASAP. No prior experience is required to be a stall convener, other than to have some fun and create a good positive vibe around the fete. Volunteers will be needed for the set up day on Saturday 25 August, as well as on fete day. Please let the school office know of your availability and what you can help with.

Two books of tickets for the multi-draw raffle will go out to families in the week beginning 18 June 2018. The cost of each ticket will be \$2 (the same as in previous years) and there will be 10 tickets per book. This year, we are going to do something a little different. The family that sells the most complete books of tickets will win 4 wristbands for the amusement rides. The wristbands will allow 4 people to go on as many rides throughout the Community Bash as they want. This prize is worth over \$100. To be eligible for the prize, all sold books of tickets must be returned to the school office by the end of the school day on Monday 20 August 2018.

The cost for ride wristbands have been determined as follows:-

- \$30 each pre-purchased
- \$35 purchased on Community Bash day
- \$5 for individual ride tickets purchased on the day

The amusement rides at this year's Community Bash are the Junior Ferris Wheel, Gladiator Duel, Tribal Encounter Jumping Castle and Triple Screamer Giant Slide.

The order form for the ride wristbands will be sent out to families early in Term 3, but something to note is that ride wristbands can be ordered for anyone attending the Community Bash; it is not exclusive to children currently enrolled at St Brendan's.

The success of the Community Bash relies heavily on the support of the school community by way of the donation of good quality items that can be sold on the stalls. Some items that we are looking for include:-

- The Pre-loved and Vintage Goods Garage Sale stall:-
  - Pre-loved clothes, shoes or toys
  - CDs or DVDs
  - Manchester (bathroom, kitchen, bedroom items)
  - Household items (kitchen or garden utensils)
- Books, including fiction and non-fiction
- Plants or plant cuttings as well as any spare pots and cool-lite boxes for the Plants Stall
- Home-made jams and chutneys
- Empty glass jars with lids (for jams)
- Cakes of all sorts
- Sweets, including slices, tarts, pies, lollies, toffies, fudge
- Arts and craft items
- Blocks of chocolate and novelty items as prizes for the Sideshow Alley games
- Cans of soft drink (375ml) and bottled water (425ml) for the Café/BBQ

The next fete planning meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 20 June at 7pm at The Salisbury Hotel. You can purchase a meal or drink from the restaurant and there is a play area for the kids to amuse themselves. Everyone is welcome.
